Position of Leadership Duties and Requirements

Junior Assistant Scoutmaster

These items must be accomplished to the best of the scout's ability, or completed to the satisfaction of the troop's Scoutmasters in order to receive credit for this troop level position of responsibility. The scout will be expected to complete a "*Self Assessment*" form and present it at the Scoutmaster Conference upon the conclusion of this position's term.

Term: One Year

During his term of office, the Junior Assistant Scoutmaster must:

- Functions as an Assistant Scoutmaster with duties and responsibilities identical to those of other Assistant Scoutmasters (except where BSA policy requires an adult of at least age 18)
- Attend at least 2/3 of the troop's monthly outings
- Participate in the preparation and facilitation of monthly outings
- Attend at least 2/3's of the troop meetings
- Participate in the preparation and facilitation of troop meetings
- Attend at least 2/3's of the troop's monthly Scoutmaster meetings
- Attend Courts of Honor
- Participate in and assist the Scoutmaster with Troop Leadership Training
- Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law
- Show Scout spirit
- Lead by setting a good example for other Scouts
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Scoutmaster
- Be certified by the Scoutmaster that you have adequately completed the duties and requirements of this position.

Qualifications for the position of Junior Assistant Scoutmaster are:

- Age 16 minimum
- Must have demonstrated outstanding leadership skills
- Must be Life Rank or higher

- Must have been a member of Troop 147 for a minimum of 1 year
- Must have successfully served at least one complete term as Senior Patrol Leader or Assistant Senior Patrol Leader
- Must have successfully completed Troop Leadership Training and National Youth Leadership Training
- Must have actively participated in long and short term camping with Troop 147

Statement of Commitment:

Having been appointed to the position of Junior Assistant Scoutmaster, I hereby promise to cheerfully perform all the duties of my office as stated above and commit to the above participation requirements. I understand that failure to honor this commitment during my term of office may result in the loss of my leadership position and/or the loss of leadership credit toward my rank advancement.
